## How can we use our spiritual gifts to serve God's mission in the world?

**Leadership:** Christian leaders in local government, education, business, entrepreneurs, and visionaries.

**Administration:** organizing events to bring people together for the common good, supporting organizations that serve people, and bless communities.

**Teaching:** shaping the next generation at an after-school program, supporting kids or adults who need assistance with education or skills for life.

**Knowledge:** using godly insights to influence people and situations for good, speaking truth into people's lives to open doors to faith.

**Wisdom:** mediating, advising others through conflicts, helping a community navigate changes and challenges.

**Prophecy:** advocacy work for justice, speaking truth into people's lives in your workplace.

**Discernment:** aiding in bringing truth and justice, therapists who sense what's under the surface to help bring a resolution, and perceiving someone's real need.

**Exhortation:** encouraging others in the community, changing the culture of an organization or workplace, building someone up when they are struggling, being a voice in the world that inspires and unites.

**Shepherding:** offering counsel and guidance, caring for one another, guarding and shaping others' lives, and mentoring.

**Faith:** entrepreneurs, starting ventures that benefit the community, activist work, and helping friends stay steady in a crisis.

**Evangelism:** storytellers, influencers, sharing hope in everyday conversations, missionaries in your own backyard.

**Apostleship:** innovators who start new initiatives for the good of communities, bridge-builders who connect cultures and ideas, opening new paths where none existed before.

**Service/Helps:** volunteering at places of support (shelters, hospitals, nursing homes), small acts of love in the schools or businesses, random acts of kindness during errands.

**Mercy:** being a friend who listens, caring for others and sitting in your friend's season of life, serving in places of support and need (community centers, prisons, shelters, rehab, support groups)

**Giving:** philanthropy work, sharing resources, time, and skills, cultivating generosity in a community, supporting Kingdom-based non-profits, drawing attention to areas of need.

**Hospitality:** inviting people into your home, serving meals, creating safe environments, and community builders who make others feel like family.
